

Senate Appointed Positions
Resolution 2011-03

Whereas, the Academic Senate is the organization whose primary function is to make recommendations with respect to academic and professional matters (Title 5, 53200) and is primarily relied upon for curriculum and instruction, for grading policies, for student preparation and success, and for degree and certificate requirements (Board Policy 3255); and,

Whereas, the Academic Senate President is responsible for appointing multiple reassignment opportunities to faculty, and faculty in these appointments are responsible to the Academic Senate for the duties within these positions; and,

Whereas, continuity in assignments are often difficult to maintain, yet vital to programs under the Academic Senate purview;

Resolved, the Academic Senate recommends that all coordinator positions be reduced to 2 years of appointment, effective with appointments made for Fall 2012; and,

Resolved, the Academic Senate recommends that all assistant coordinator positions be increased to 2 years of appointment, effective with appointments made for Fall 2011; and,

Resolved, the Academic Senate recommends that all assistant coordinator positions be made on odd numbered years effective with appointments made for Fall 2011, and that all coordinator positions be made on even number years effective with appointments made for Fall 2012; and,

Resolved, the Academic Senate directs the Academic Senate President to reaffirm all appointments annually with Executive Board approval, subject to evaluation by the appropriate manager and the Senate President.
