- Basic Needs Resources Rigo
 - CalFresh Outreach (regular updates): May is CalFresh Awareness Month! Vivian and her team will be providing personalized application assistance at planned events for CFO Awareness Month. On May 22nd in the 9C stage, LA County Public Social Services will be on campus to help students apply for benefits. Currently there are 11 students registered to meet with LA County Social Services workers who will help with CalFresh and Medi-Cal applications. Light refreshments and food will be served at this event. Vivian thanked her team for all the help with planning for this event.
 - Mountie Fresh Food Pantry and Snack Rac: Vivian has encouraged students to visit the food pantry this week. Snack Racks have been replenished around campus.
 - Housing: Lorena shared that since July 3, 2023 May 17, 2024, case workers have had 1,417 appointments with students, they have housed 74 students and 25 students from Jovenes have been housed. Will be hiring additional student navigators, currently they have 25 applicants, and she will be starting the interview process next week. They advertised these positions on social media.
