- Welcome new faculty member to BNC, Thuy Pham: Pauline introduced our new BNC member.
- Basic Needs Resources (Rigo)
 - CalFresh Outreach (regular updates Rigo/Brenda): Brenda shared that on 2/18, thanks to the help from Financial Aid office, letters were sent out to students informing students of their eligibility for Cal Fresh. Brenda and the team have been reaching out and following up with students. Many students have received their EBT cards, funds, etc. Also they have been working and hosting office hours with DHH and ACCESS. CFO workshops are scheduled with the ASPIRE program, they will be answering questions and help students apply for Cal Fresh in breakout rooms. Rigo shared, as of today there are 480 Cal Fresh applicants. The website is user friendly so this has helped students who are applying independently. Also, working with non-credit and working with ESL counselors to provide presentations to their students. Rigo shared Cal Fresh benefits are year round and him and his team can schedule presentations, contact Rigo if you are interested in a presentation for your students on Cal Fresh.
 - Mountie Fresh Food Pantry (Rigo)
 - Next Drive-Thru Pantry @ Lot A on 3/3/21 from 10:00-12:00. Registration system is the same for the spring term. Numbers have been consistent 200-225 students in attendance.
 - Trustee Peter Hidalgo will be joining the pantry distribution
 - Tzu Chi Foundation Together We Rise has launched, Rigo provided background information and the launch of this subsidy program and the criteria that students would meet. Reported out that 9 official applications have been submitted, the deadline is March 8th. Working closely with students on navigating the application process. Rigo is confident that all 15 scholarships will be granted to our students.

- Spring Flex Day Reactions: Shelly, Barbara, Marissa shared their reactions to hearing Sara Goldrick-Rab. Pauline shared the syllabus statement with faculty. Rigo reported on how the presentation with Koji went and how they incorporated Mt. SAC data into their presentation. Shifted their conversation of Basic Needs to the importance of trauma informed care and best practices. Rigo asked Pauline if he get the materials that was presented at the trauma informed care workshop.
