II. New Business

- A. Accreditation – Michelle Sampat
 - Michelle Sampat reported the college is in the process of drafting the ISER for ACCJC accreditation review.
 - Outcomes is a big portion of Standard 2A but is sprinkled throughout.
 - Course SLOs, PLOs along with outcomes from all areas of the campus (student services, HR, IT...)
 - What are we doing to make sure that SLOs are transparent and evaluated for all courses and that PLOs are addressed as well?
 - Gather data on how we are using this data to make updates
 - **Need from us a keen eye on where we are and where we are going**
 - The OC will participate in this process in one of 2 ways:
 1. A member of the OC may be asked to be a member of the Standard 2A weaving team (writing team)
 2. OC support weaving teams by serving as a resource for all weaving teams
 - Committees may need to highlight something from their minutes that aligns with the standards – examples of how you are moving your committee forward
- B. Qualitative Check for SLO – approval for new process & codes
 - Annel reported on how the process has been streamlined
 - Loni to update the comment list and will send out to Tammy, Chris and Kelly
 - New streamlined process and comment change approved
- C. Society for College & University Planning Conference – Kelly Coreas attended the 3-day conference and reported that it was about planning, handouts were emailed

III. Old Business

- A. TiLT Update
 - Loni summarized the TiLT program, ongoing since spring 2020
 - Annel reported findings from a student survey and focus group
 - Survey: results were good overall (25 responses in total)
 - Focus group: everyone was happy with their experiences but a few students were confused about the purpose
 - Positive comments from students: assignments are more in depth and clearer
 - TiLT program will continue through spring 2022
 - Loni will check in with individual faculty to see who will be participating in TiLT this semester and will continue to advertise TiLT to all faculty
- B. President's Award in Excellence & Innovation in 4 categories
 - Not a lot of people apply
 - The committee discussed how to market this award to faculty so that we can hopefully have more award recipients this year
 - Plan to send information out earlier in the semester
 - Deadline May 2, 2022
- C. PLO Liaisons Update
 - GPS Mini-grant proposal for Faculty Liaisons for Assessment of Program Learning Outcomes (PLO) has been approved by the GPS Council for an additional funding to extend the project through Spring 2022
 - 7 of the 8 previous PLO Liaisons will continue this semester
- D. SLO Student Partnership Project Update
 - Loni has been working with 2 students to assess what students know about SLO
 - Funding is through SEED
 - All three will meet with research for help w/ designing and implementing survey
- E. Technology-NuVentive, Canvas, and Banner Data Pilot
 - Pull data from Canvas and Banner into NuVentive to look at SLO s through the lens of equity
 - Need more feedback from faculty to see how well this works
 - Next step is to forward this info to Kate Morales
 - We will continue to try this out and hope to roll this out to all faculty
