	AP 7211 Update – Minimum Qualifications and Equivalencies	AP 7211 has been approved by AMAC! The committee will use this AP to determine whether a given proposal is acceptable.								
	Japanese – Proposed Change (revised)	Recommended for approval by the Senate.								
	Equivalency Review Letter When Old Equivalency Exists	Approved with modifications. The committee agreed to add the phrase "A minimum of twelve semester units is generally expected" by the committee when requesting an equivalency for a discipline requiring a master's degree.								
	Submitted "No Equivalency Desired" Requests: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Health</li> <li>■ Ecology</li> <li>■ Physical Therapy Aide</li> <li>■ Real Estate</li> </ul>	Approved. Although disciplines need not submit "No Equivalency Desired" requests, doing so helps the Senate to maintain accurate records.								
	Prescreening of Outdated (pre-2007) Equivalencies <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Art</li> <li>■ Computer Information Systems</li> <li>■ Family and Consumer Sciences</li> <li>■ Communication</li> <li>■ Agriculture</li> <li>■ Physics</li> </ul>	The committee reviewed existing equivalencies for Art, CIS, FCS, Communication, Agriculture, and Physics. General comments were: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Equivalencies for vocational disciplines (those not requiring a master's degree) <u>must</u> have at least two years of work experience and the minimum of eighteen <u>semester</u> units of General Education specified in Title 5 Section 55063. A master's degree by itself does not meet the two years of work experience requirement.</li> <li>■ Equivalencies must state whether they are intended to <u>supersede</u> the state's stated minimum qualification or whether they are intended to <u>provide an additional means</u> of qualifying for employment at Mt. SAC. The form will be updated to reflect this.</li> <li>■ An equivalency can only be made to an official state discipline, and each course must be assigned to at least one discipline.</li> </ul>
