3. Web & Portal Update: Askjoe and MountieApp	Eric Turner reviewed phase I of the Askjoe Mountie project and did a demonstration. This new feature is on every webpage and allows a user to ask questions and receive the 'best' answer from Joe. This feature was originally developed for Student Services, but other teams have shown an interest in providing information for common questions their departments routinely answer. Phase II of the project will require additional funding that has not been identified yet. It would allow for an authenticated user to receive answers to questions like, 'what grade did I receive in Math 100?' Eric also reviewed and did a demonstration of the new version of the Mountie App that includes the ability for students to register for classes and pay fees with deep links into Banner. Several committee members commented that they used the map feature during the first week of school to assist students with finding their classes.	Information only. IIIC

IT is continuing to setup and deploy JAMF,	

	which allows for the remote management of Apple devices. The Academic Technology team also participated in the setup and deployment of approximately 500 devices for the Promise Plus grant initiative. Ron also encouraged everyone to share with their departments that Apple devices should be purchased directly from Apple. They should not be purchased through Amazon, Best Buy, or other third-party retail sites.
