








## AB 368 (Currently Active)

- Further sets the stage for the Chancellor's goal of enrolling 250,000 9<sup>th</sup> grade students into CCC during their freshman year
- Outlines/defines "underrepresented in higher education" definition to more easily enroll these students across the state. Earlier versions of the CCAP language focused on "high achieving" students language.





## AB 1342 (Currently Active, however)

- Special Admits/Dual Enrollments are still FTF even though they may have completed units while still in high school via Dual Enrollment
- Mt. SAC does not use AB 19 (California College Promise Fee Waiver Funds) for fee waivers, so it doesn't apply to us.
