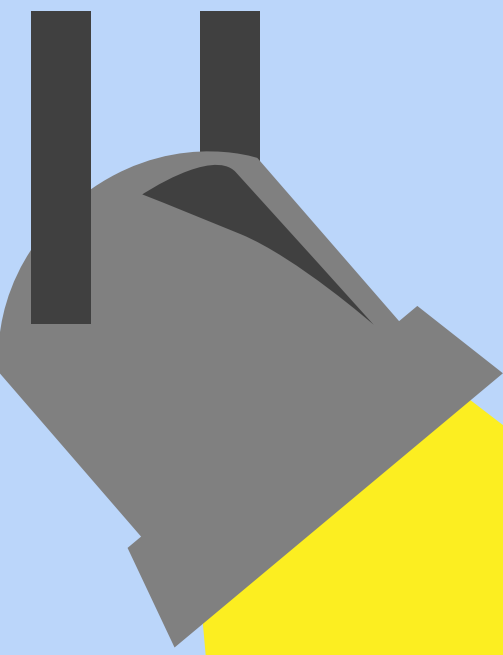

Administration of Justice

- The **Certificate in Administration of Justice program** is intended to prepare students for entry-level law enforcement.
- The courses emphasize the modern role of law enforcement and corrections within the criminal justice systems. Written and oral communication skills are a consistent focus.
- Entry-level employment opportunities after program completion may include law enforcement as peace officers, corrections officers, custodial officers, non-sworn security and investigations, other non-sworn positions in law enforcement, and public service.
- Average pay ranges from mid \$80,000 to \$110,000.

- **Work Experience Program** with partner agencies such as Covina, Walnut Sheriffs, Monrovia Park Ranger, Mt. SAC Police & Campus Safety, LAPD, LASD, SFPD, CHP, Orange County Sheriffs, Inglewood PD, and US Customs and Border Protection. These agencies regularly recruit our students for employment.
- Employers are seeking diversity in their hiring and openings for non-traditional career seekers to enter the profession.
