ADMISSION ASSESSMENT TEST PROCEDURES

Purpose:

To standardize the admission assessment testing procedures, including passing score and admission merit points distribution.

Procedures:

1. All applicants who are randomly selected from the applicant pool will need to take the California Community Colleges Chancellor's office required admission/readiness exam.
2. Two admission/readiness exams were approved by the California Community Colleges Chancellor's office: ATI TEAS and Elsevier HESI A2 Assessment Exam.

3. If ATI TEAS Exam is used, the grade and merit points allocation are stated as follows:

Score%	Merit Points
90-100%	8
78-89%	6
71-77%	4
62-70%	2
< 62%	0

4. If the Elsevier HESI A2 Exam is used, the grade and merit points allocation are stated as follows:

Score%	Merit Points
90-100%	8
82-89.99%	6
75-81.99	4
70-74.99	2
< 70%	0

5. Applicants are allowed to take the required admission/readiness exam once a year.
6. Applicants who failed the required admission/readiness exam will be placed in a remediation program. Applicants are allowed to retake the admission/readiness exam after completion of the remediation program.
