



President's Cabinet Action Notes July 9, 2024

- 1. Cabinet reviewed and commented on the following standing items:
 - a. The <u>Request to Fill Log</u> was approved for the following positions:
 - <u>Coordinator, Project/Program</u> (Rising Scholars)
 - <u>Project/Program Specialist</u> (Rising Scholars)
 - b. The following Emergency Funding requests were approved:
 - <u>Administrative Services</u> \$28,250 one-time funding allocation was approved to cover the administration of a survey focused on the feasibility of passing a future bond measure.
 - <u>Administrative Services</u> \$50,000 one-time funding allocation was approved to cover the cost of targeted digital messaging targeting District residents.
- 2. Cabinet reviewed the vacant position lists, including positions that became or will become vacant due to the retirement incentive.
- 3. Currently, the Adult Basic Education department is operating until 8:00 p.m. daily. However, post-pandemic, programs are being offered mostly online during the evening. The department is proposing to change its operating hours to close at 6:00 p.m., due to very few students attending past 6:00 p.m. Cabinet agreed that beginning Fall 2024, it is reasonable for the department to shorten its hours to a 7:00 p.m. closing time with a reassessment of student utilization and needs to determine the impact to students.
